



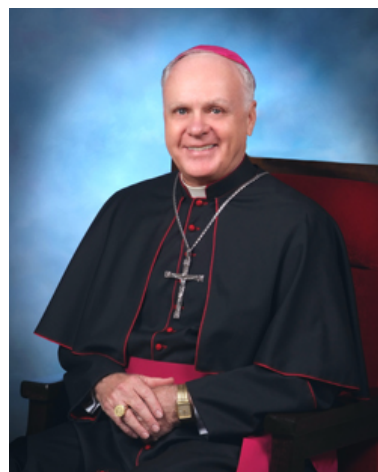
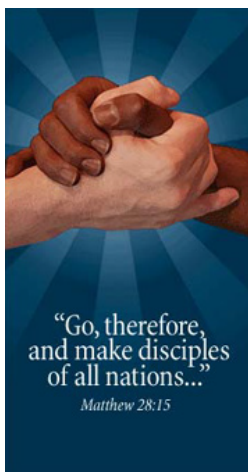
2010 CMF Conference is March 20, 2010 at The Immaculate Conception Campus Former High School Building

2010 Conference Speakers



George Weigel, Distinguished Senior Fellow of the Ethics and Public Policy Center, is a Catholic theologian and one of America's leading public intellectuals.

Weigel is the author or editor of many books, including *The Final Revolution*, *The Resistance Church and Collapse of Communism* (Oxford, 1992); *Witness to Hope* (HarperCollins, 1999); and *God's Choice: Pope Benedict XVI and the Future of the Catholic Church* (HarperCollins, 2005).

From 1989 through June 1996, Weigel was president of the Ethics and Public Policy Center, where he led a wide-ranging, ecumenical and inter-religious program of research and publication on foreign and domestic policy issues.

Rev. Rick Wendell. As a thirty year old carpenter and soon to be married, Rick was involved in a construction accident that left him clinically dead for nearly three hours. During that time he had an out of body experience. Later, on an unplanned trip with his mother to Medjugorje, Yugoslavia, Our Lord appeared to him as The Good Sheppard and asked him to become a priest.

Rick entered the Seminary, and began a long and arduous road to the priesthood. Fr. Rick was Ordained in May, 2006, in Milwaukee, Wisconsin and is now pastor at Tri-Parish Catholic Churches of Southwest Dodge County WI. The individual parishes are: St. Columbkille, Columbus, WI; St. John the Baptist, Clyman WI; and Holy Family, Reeseville, WI. His amazing story of life, death and the graces he was given in Medjugorje will truly touch you.



Rev. Thomas J. Euteneuer became president of Human Life International in December 2000. Human Life International is the world's largest pro-life organization with affiliate offices and associates in eighty countries around the world. In nine years of service to this unique mission Fr. Euteneuer has traveled more than one million miles as a pro-life missionary and has visited fifty-seven countries.

While in college, Fr. Euteneuer participated in the Marine Corps Officer Candidate Program, attended basic training at Quantico, Virginia and graduated at the top of his Company. After discerning that the Lord was calling him to the priesthood rather than the military, he entered the seminary. His pro-life activity began in the early years of his priesthood with prayer vigils, pilgrimages, pickets at abortion mills, sidewalk counseling and the establishment of a crisis pregnancy center across the street from an abortion mill in 1999.
